United Overseas Bank (Thai) Public Company Limited ("the Bank") has cancelled of ATM / Debit Magnetic card service for all existing ATM Magnetic cardholders from 16 January 2020 onwards refer to this announcement. Cardholders can request a card replacement by issuing a Debit Chip card at any UOB branch with fee charged as selected card type per the bank announced.

For annual fee refund of ATM /Debit magnetic card, the Bank has refunded the remaining card fee service into account linked with the card in September 2020.
